RLIN and RLG Databases

LIBRARIES

The Research Libraries Group's (RLG) *Eureka on the Web* search service provides access to a variety of specialized online research databases. The following databases are available through *Eureka on the Web*:

- **RLIN** - union catalog of books, archives, manuscripts, maps, scores, etc. from major research, academic, law, medical, theological, art, music, and corporate libraries.
- **English Short Title Catalog (ESTC)** - printed materials from England from 1473-1800.
- **Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals** (1977-present) - article database on architecture.
- **Anthropological Literature** – citation index to journal articles and essays on archeology and anthropology since the 19th century.
- **Bibliography of the History of Art (BHA)** (1970-present) – citation database covering journal articles, dissertations, conference proceedings, etc. covering art of the Americas and Europe from the 4th century to modern times.

Materials indexed in these databases but not owned by Binghamton University Libraries can be obtained through Inter-Library Loan for campus community members.

BASIC SEARCHING

The Simple Screen allows for quick searching using short phrases or single words. Truncation (using a ?) is supported.

Author (person or organization)	morrison, toni bourke-white, margaret council on foreign relations
Title (series, journal, parts of a collection) - include punctuation, but omit () and ;	room of one's own advances in laser science amazing soda-pop stretcher
Keyword - words must all come from one author's name, one title, or one subject heading (implied Boolean)	seismic policies bibliograph? costume?
Exact Subject Headings	prints--20th century vietnamese conflict

ADVANCED SEARCHING

Using the Advanced Search screen, you can limit your search by language, material format or date. Searches can also be combined using the Boolean Logic operators *And*, *Or*, and *And not*.

Examples of each search appear on the right of the screen, with additional examples at the bottom. A Help screen is accessible on the top right of the screen.

DISPLAYING SEARCH RESULTS

Brief Display Displays records in one line with the date of publication. Sets of 250 or fewer records are sorted by author, then title, then date. Provides list of libraries that own item.

Full Display Displays record in detailed format (complete title, notes, subject headings.) Authors, titles, subjects appear as hypertext links; click on them to search for other records by the same author, title, or subject.
If Binghamton University owns the item, a note will appear in "location."

NAVIGATING

List Display list of results as brief records (from the Full display).

Refine Return to Advanced Search screen.

Limit Narrows the search by date, country of publication, language, material type, RLIN file, or location code.

Previous Searches Provides search history.

PRINTING OR EMAILING RECORDS

Single records or groups of records can be printed, emailed, or saved using the buttons provided on the top of the result list. Groups of up to 50 records can be printed or emailed at a time by putting checkmarks next to selected records.

To receive the full view of selected records, be sure to click the "Full" button before selecting print, save or email.

SFX

The Eureka on the Web service supports SFX. The SFX button appears in the full record display.

LOGGING OFF

Always click **EXIT** to end your session.
