

## Accessing Journal Article from Libraries Website

The majority of the e-reserve journal articles are available in print or via library subscription databases. Students will need the journal article citation to find the article. Below are instructions for finding articles from a citation.

Example:

Beachy, R. N. (2010). Science and Sustainability: The Emerging Consensus. *BioScience*, 60(6), 406-407.  
**doi:10.1525/bio.2010.60.6.2**

### Option #1

If there is a 'DOI' (digital object identifier) number in the citation:

**On campus:** enter the DOI number in a Google search box to find the article.

**Off-campus:** use our citation linker (located on the Library A-Z list); enter DOI and click on 'Look Up.'

### Option #2

Click on the **Journals & eBooks** tab from the Libraries homepage at <http://library.binghamton.edu/>

Enter the name of the journal title – *BioScience* – in the search box and choose 'Title Equals' from drop down box; hit search.
